# A basic low impact, low cost habitation in a biodiverse environment

- 15 sq m passive solar design
- No planning approval req
- Strip footings
- Strawbale walls
- Recycled windows & doors
- Pavers for floor (on plastic dpc)
- Rainwater capture and reticulation
- Double bed, table, sink
- Views to river and forest
- Cost \$5000









# Aims

- Easy to care for
- No spraying req
- No nets req
- Protect steep banks
- Provide privacy with evergreen spp
- Food
- Shelter from SW using evergreen trees
- Shade from West
- Deciduous shade to North
- Protected from geese + sheep
- Steps to invite orderly foot traffic

- White Sapote (better with X pollination)
- Orange (seville)
- Lime (sunrise)
- Illawarra Plum ( need male and female)
- Scrub Cherry (*Syzigium australe*)
- Grape vines

## Herb

- Bay tree

- Aloe vera



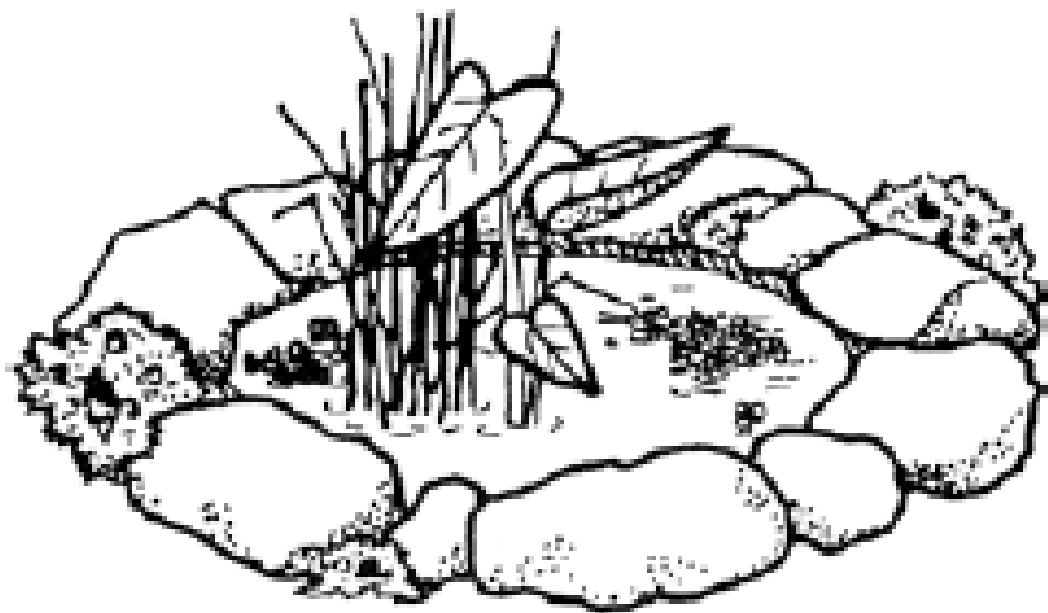

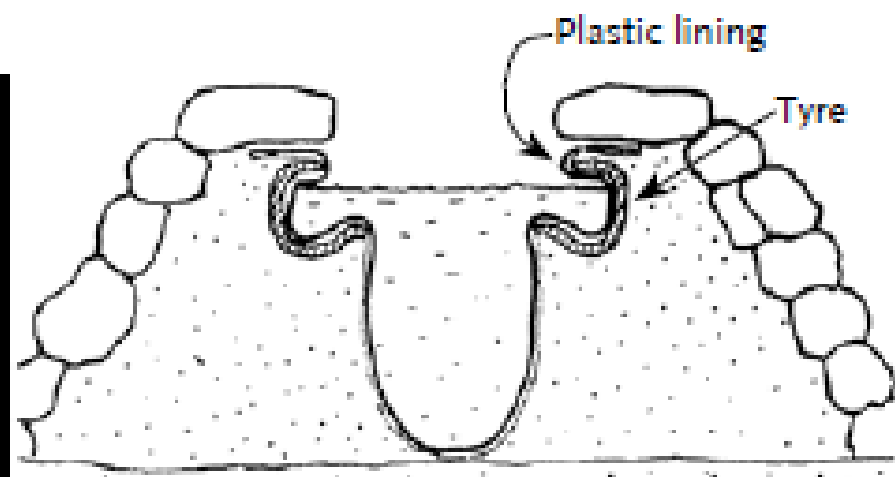
